	JF raised an issue about promotion about PCN on partnering websites. PN shared with the network that he'd found a table on DCCG website that highlights the localities of PCN and which practice resides. Action: PN to send the table to Healthwatch Doncaster to distribute to the network.
Primary Care Doncaster update – Tina Hope	Tina Hope (TH) from Primary Care Doncaster (PCD) gave an update on the Extended Access service. The service is now one year old. TH made the network aware that the PCD team have taken on board all feedback given at past PPG Network meeting by network members.
	The PCD team are looking to extend the First 2 Physio service into all hubs across Doncaster as it is only available at Central Hub but in high demand.
	RN raised concerns patients are experiencing in regards to transport and travelling to hubs. The PCS have taken on board these comments and are hoping to expand and have additional hubs across Doncaster to reduce this problem.
	TH informed the group she has not be receiving meeting papers. <b>Action:</b> EG to add onto distribution list and send future meeting dates.
Pharmacy Delivery - Geoffrey Johnson	GJ informed the network that selected Pharmacies across England will be introducing a £5 a month charge to deliver medications to patients homes.  Network members raised that Boots Pharmacy have now started to charge patients for this service. Patients have to meet the significant requirements to get them delivered free of charge. Sharps or Weldrick's Pharmacy still deliver medicines free and recommended by network members.  GJ also informed the network about the 'Doctor Doctor' text messaging service. This service has been rolled out in three different departments in DRI to remind patients about their appointment. This service has reduced the number of missed appointments overall.



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Sharing Best Practice	SL was going to share best practice, however no update due to no meeting taking place at his practice.
	PN gave an overview of his PPG and how both practices have merged into one over the past year. PN made the network aware that his PPG meet every 2 months and all information is on their website.  Action: NBS and Andrew Goodall to attend their October meeting. PN explained that his PPG have a core group and a focus
	group who meet separately to discuss different topics.
	This lead onto PL and SW expressing the struggle on getting their PPG up and running again at Scawsby Health Centre. Network members gave their ideas and guidance to how to set up a PPG and it was acknowledged that all PPG's are unique and have no set way.
