Alison Atkinson - Hate Crime Coordinator for South Yorkshire Police told the group South Yorkshire police are currently engaging with schools and people 10years+ to raise awareness/respect of hate crime. Police are training officers who deal with the people affected by hate crime so they are aware of how to react to the situation.

Andrew suggested it may be an idea to hold a workshop around hate crime/safeguarding at the Keeping Safe event.
