Dementia Awareness Week - Angela Dungworth from South Yorkshire Dementia Action Alliances (SYDAA) gave a brief overview of the project she is currently involved with.

Let's talk about dementia

Aim of the project: Maintain the independence and identity of people living with dementia; and enable people to live well with dementia safely in their own home for as long as possible.

Angela talked through the Herbert Protocol form which is designed to make sure that, if someone goes missing, the police can get access to important information about that person as soon as possible. The group felt that this is very usual source of information to have.



Sue Millward raised if there are any plans to create an easy read version.

Herbert protocol video about Dementia - The video is aimed at families, friends, carers of people living with dementia and organisations that work with anyone living with dementia.

Ballot paper was handed out to vote for the theme for this year's Safeguarding Event (Education, Communication, Empowerment). Empowerment and Communication achieved the same score.


Interesting comments and ideas were then captured from the group They felt information about the event needs to be reached to individuals and organisations we haven't yet engaged/ been involved with.
