<p>Actions from the last meeting</p> 	<p>Actions from the last meeting: At our last meeting it was asked if Dementia Support is available in Care homes. These concerns were taken to the Enter and View Group at Healthwatch to discuss. This has now been added onto their requirements to ask when carrying out care home visits.</p>
	<p>Andy Foster the Project Officer from South Yorkshire Police Community Safety Department came along to talk to us about the latest scams in South Yorkshire and how we can keep safe and share information with others.</p> <p>The total amount of fraud per year is approximately £190 billion, 9 billion of this is scams which have been targeted on elderly people.</p> <p>The forum watched a case study video on the signs of fraud, how scammers target individuals and how to avoid this.</p> <p>Andy made the forum aware there is an event on 23 August 2018 focusing on scams and financial abuse.
